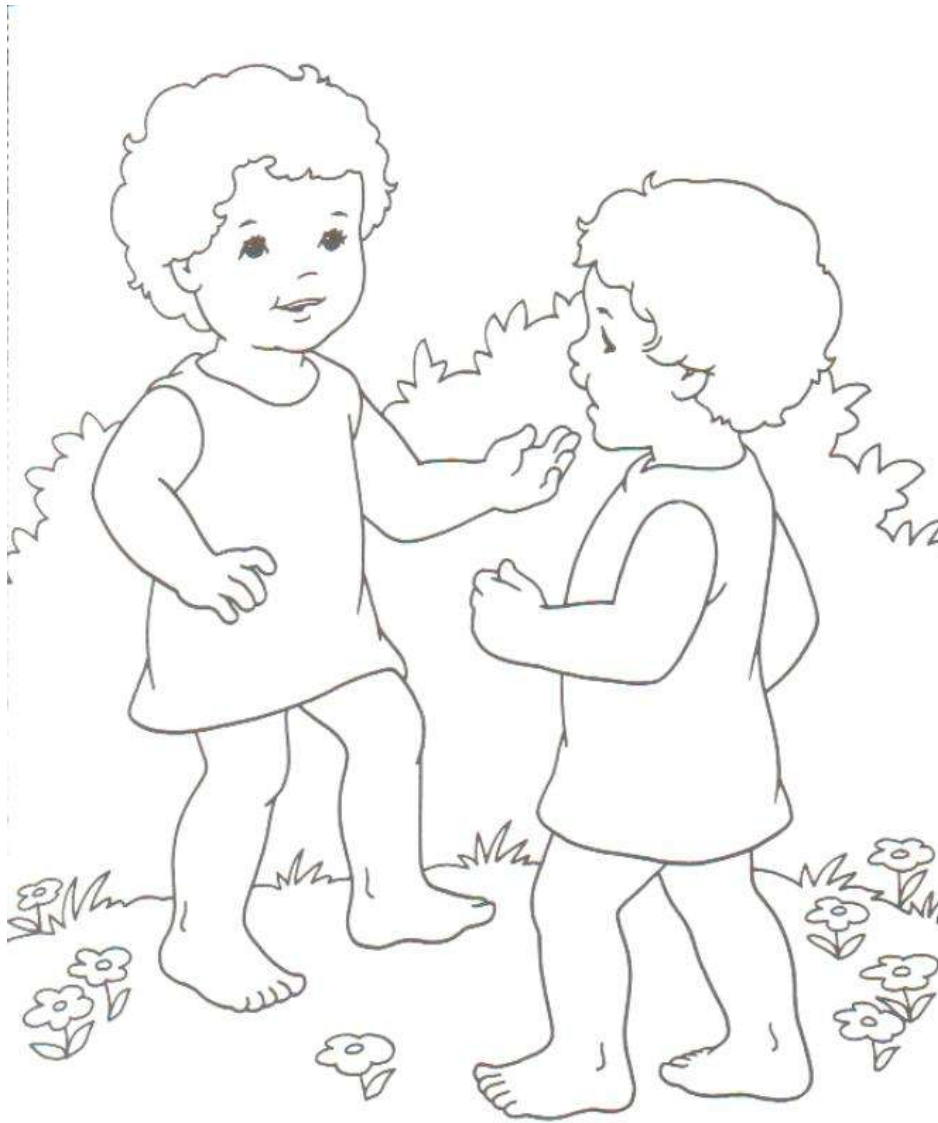

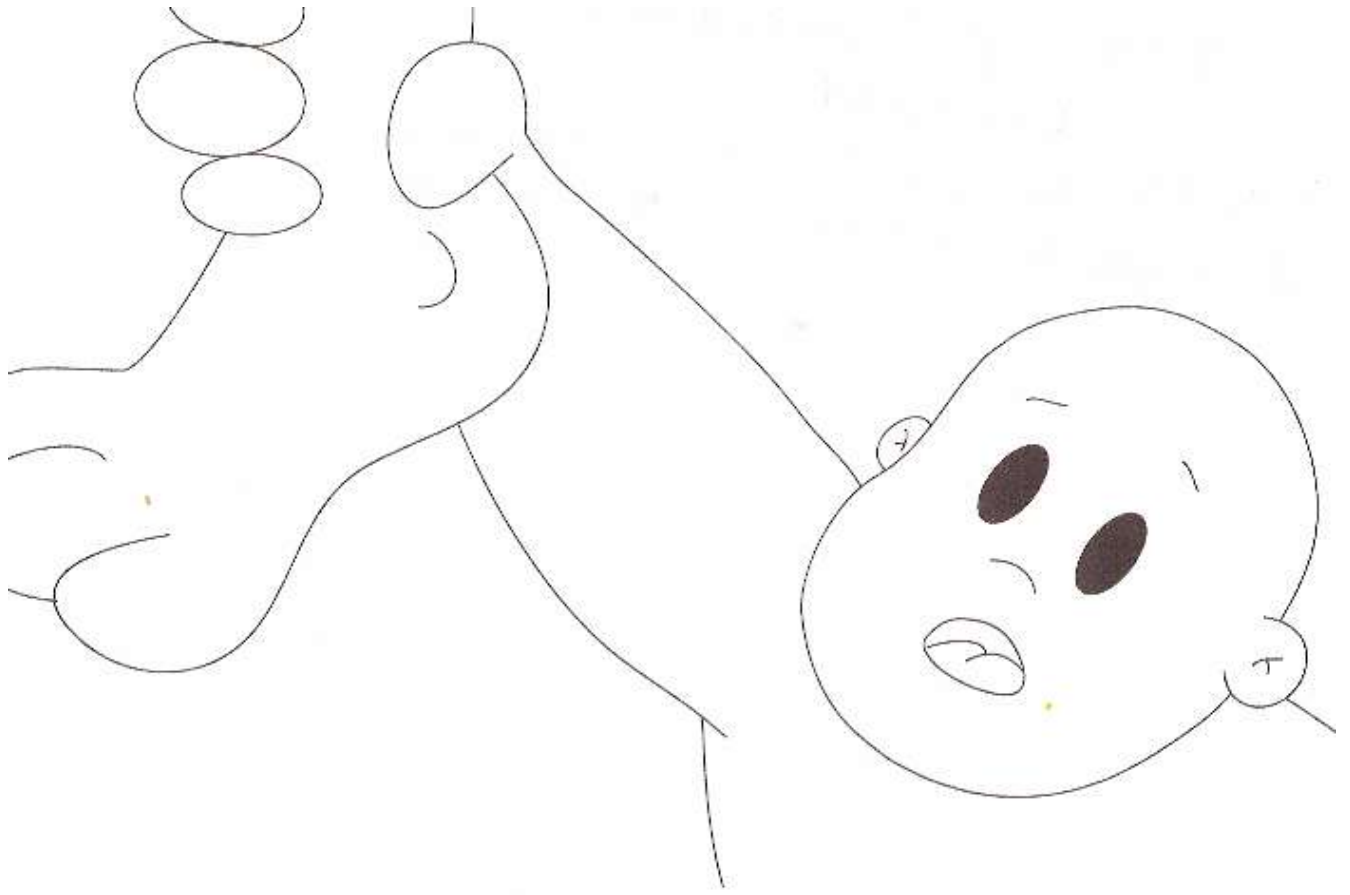
His birthright [the right to inherit God's promise to Abraham]

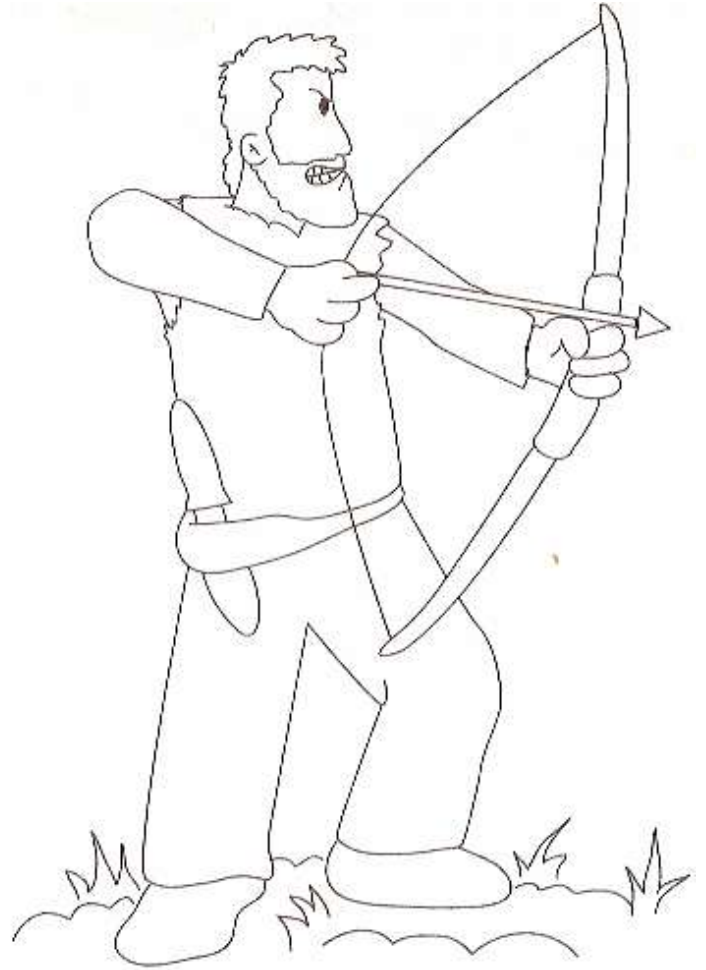
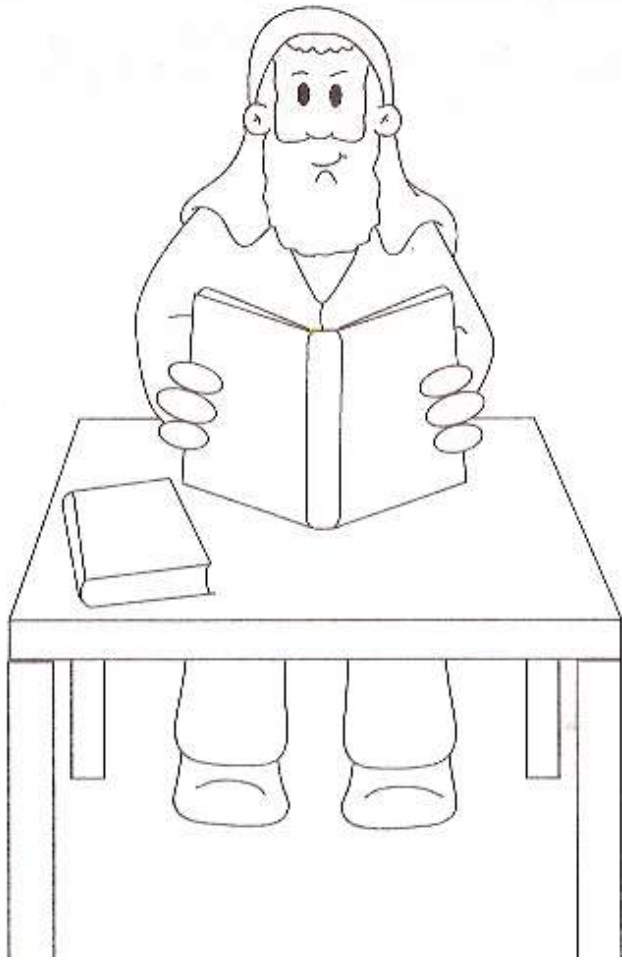


Isaac married Rebekah.

Jacob gave him some bread and soup.

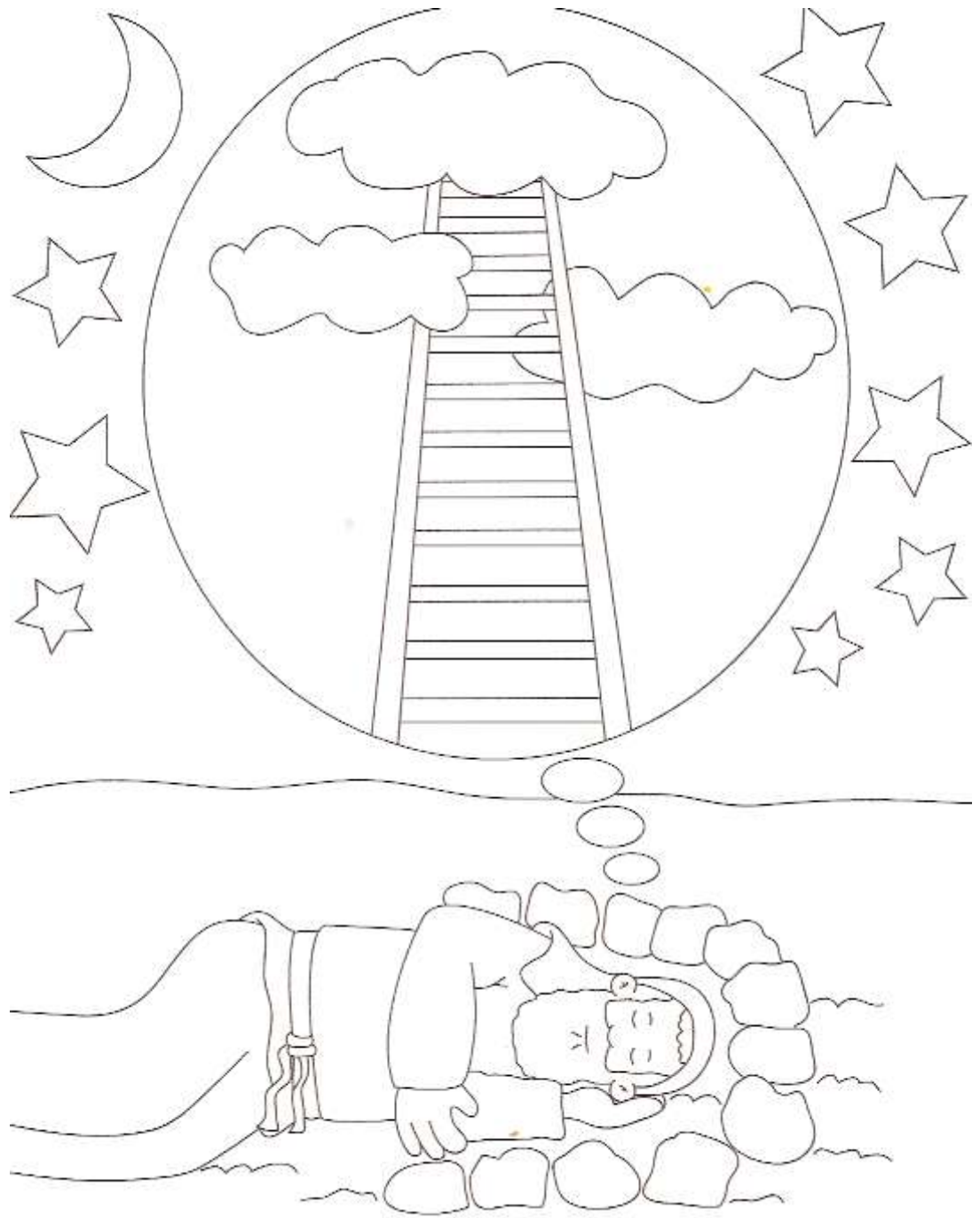


When Isaac was so old that he could not see very well he told Esau to make his favorite food so he can give Esau his birthright (the right to inherit God's promise to Abraham).

Rebekah heard them talking and dressed her favorite son, Jacob, up so that Isaac would think that he was Esau.



Before Esau returned home, Jacob brought Isaac the food he asked for and pretended to be his brother Esau. Since Isaac could not see very well he asked Jacob to come close so he could touch his son. The goat fur that Rebekah put on Jacob's arms and neck tricked Isaac into thinking that he was Esau. Jacob received the blessing of the firstborn son by making his father Isaac think he was Esau.
