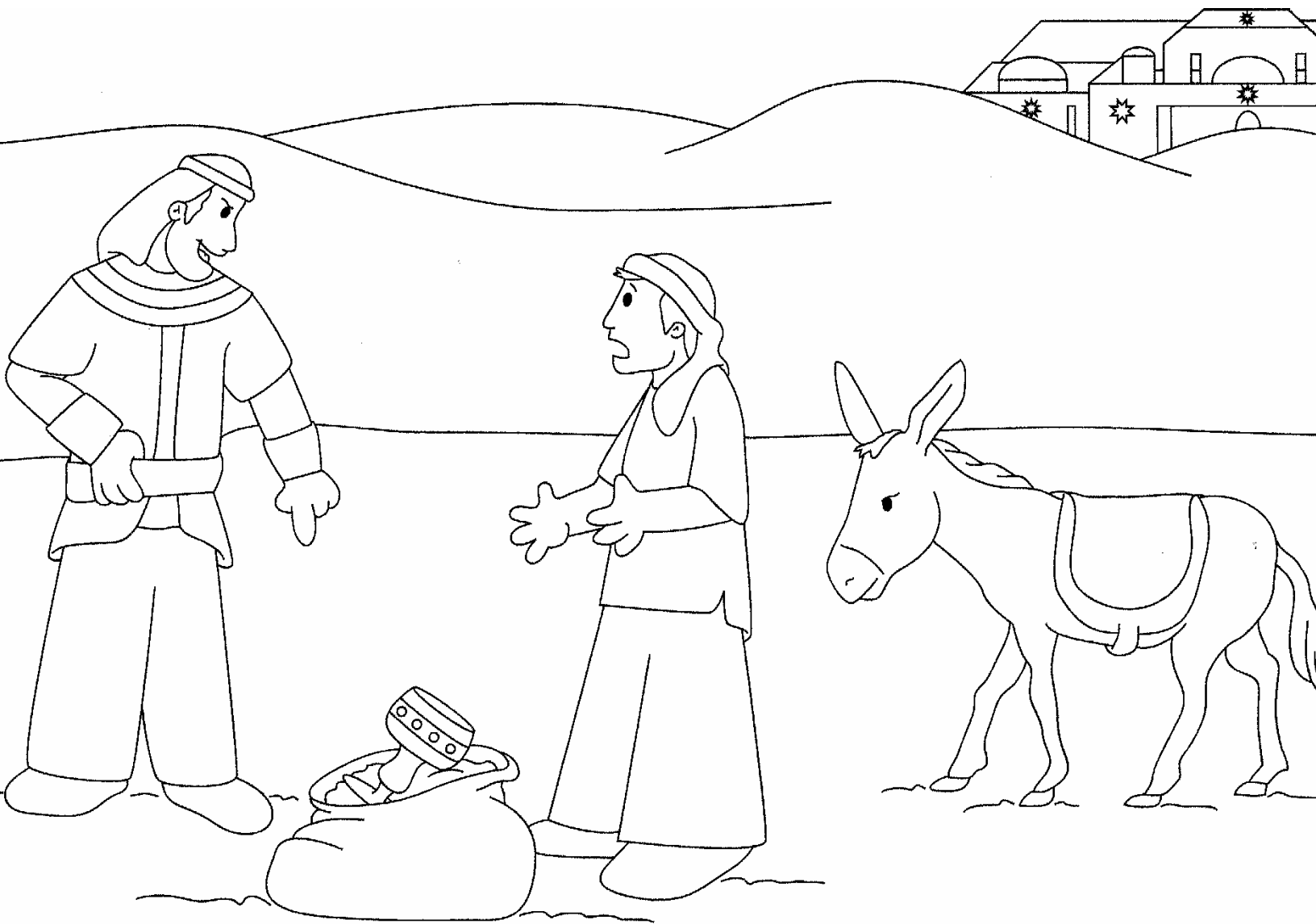
When the famine began *Joseph's brothers went to Egypt to buy food*. Joseph recognized them and said they were spies.



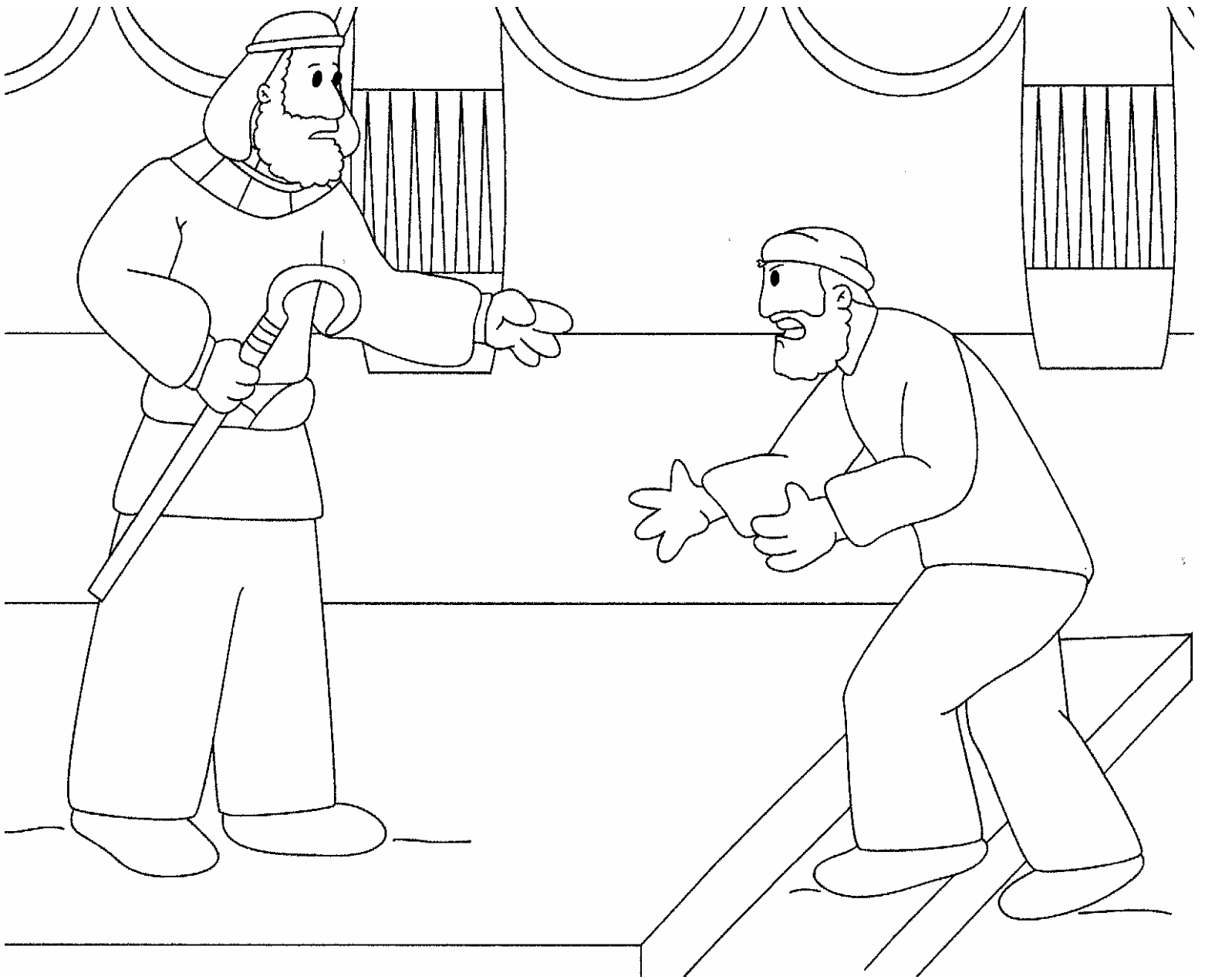
Joseph kept Simeon in prison in Egypt and told his brothers to bring back their brother Benjamin to prove that they were not spies.



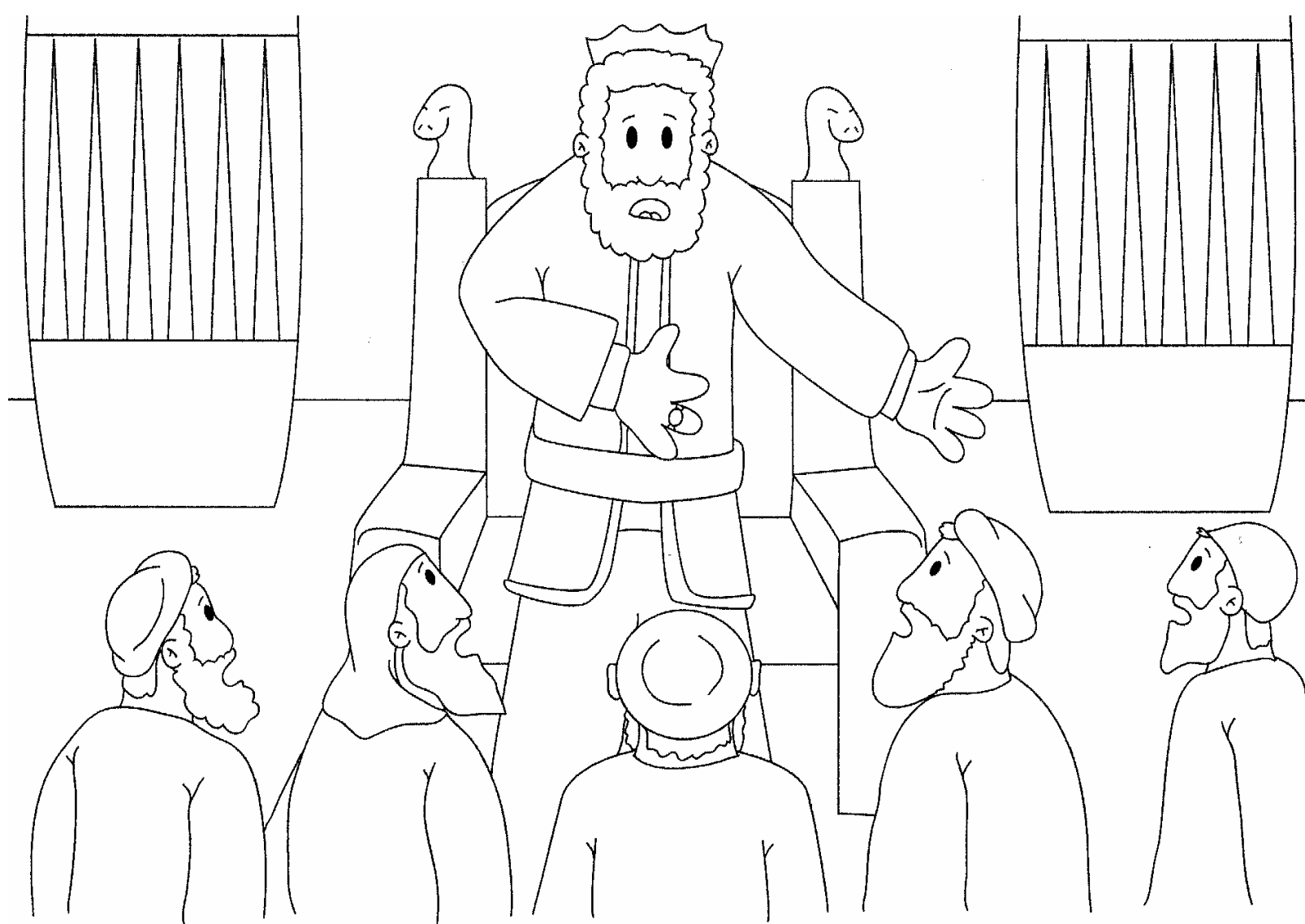
Joseph made a meal for his brothers when they returned with Benjamin. Joseph's brothers bowed down to him like they had in his dream long ago.
