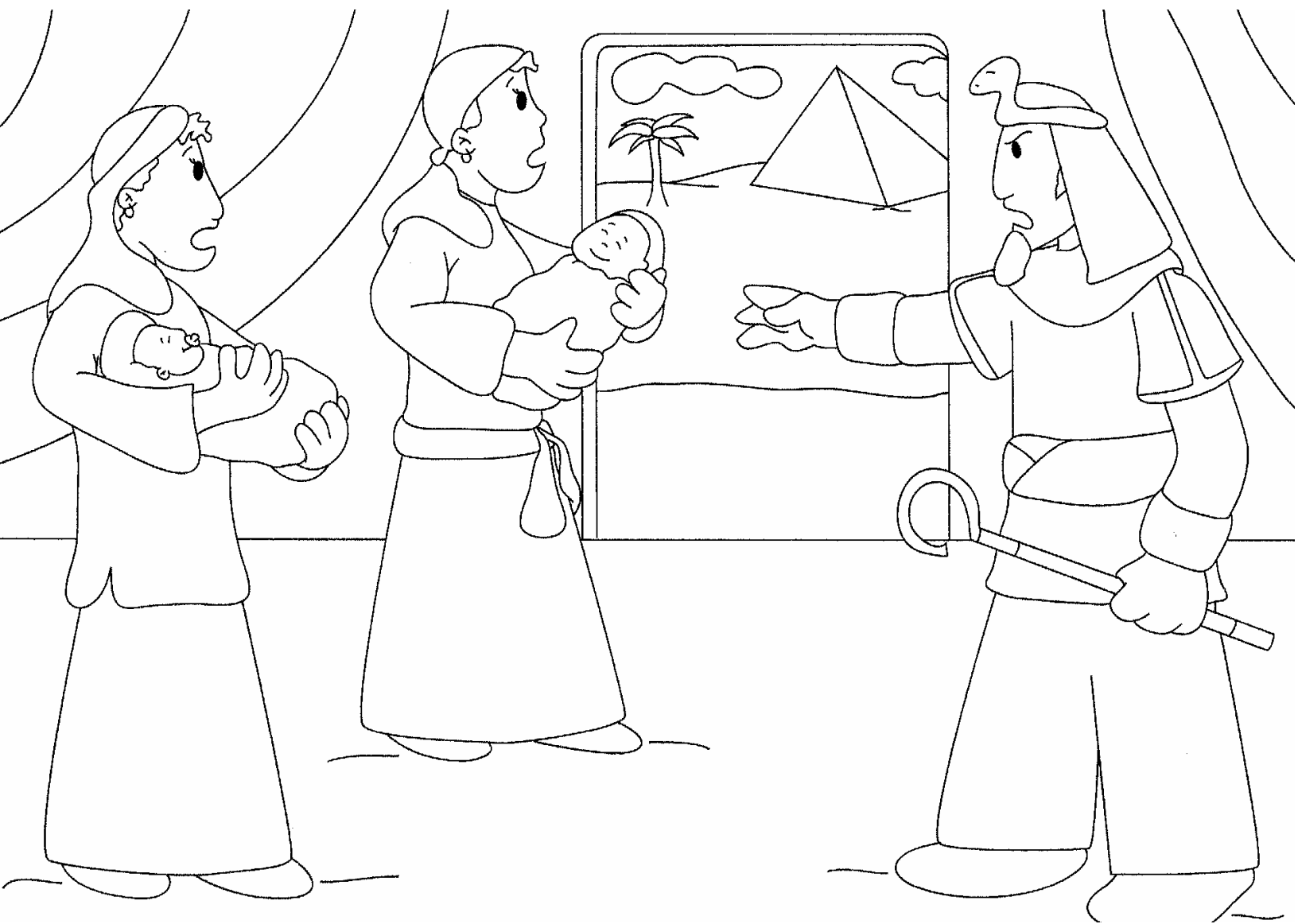

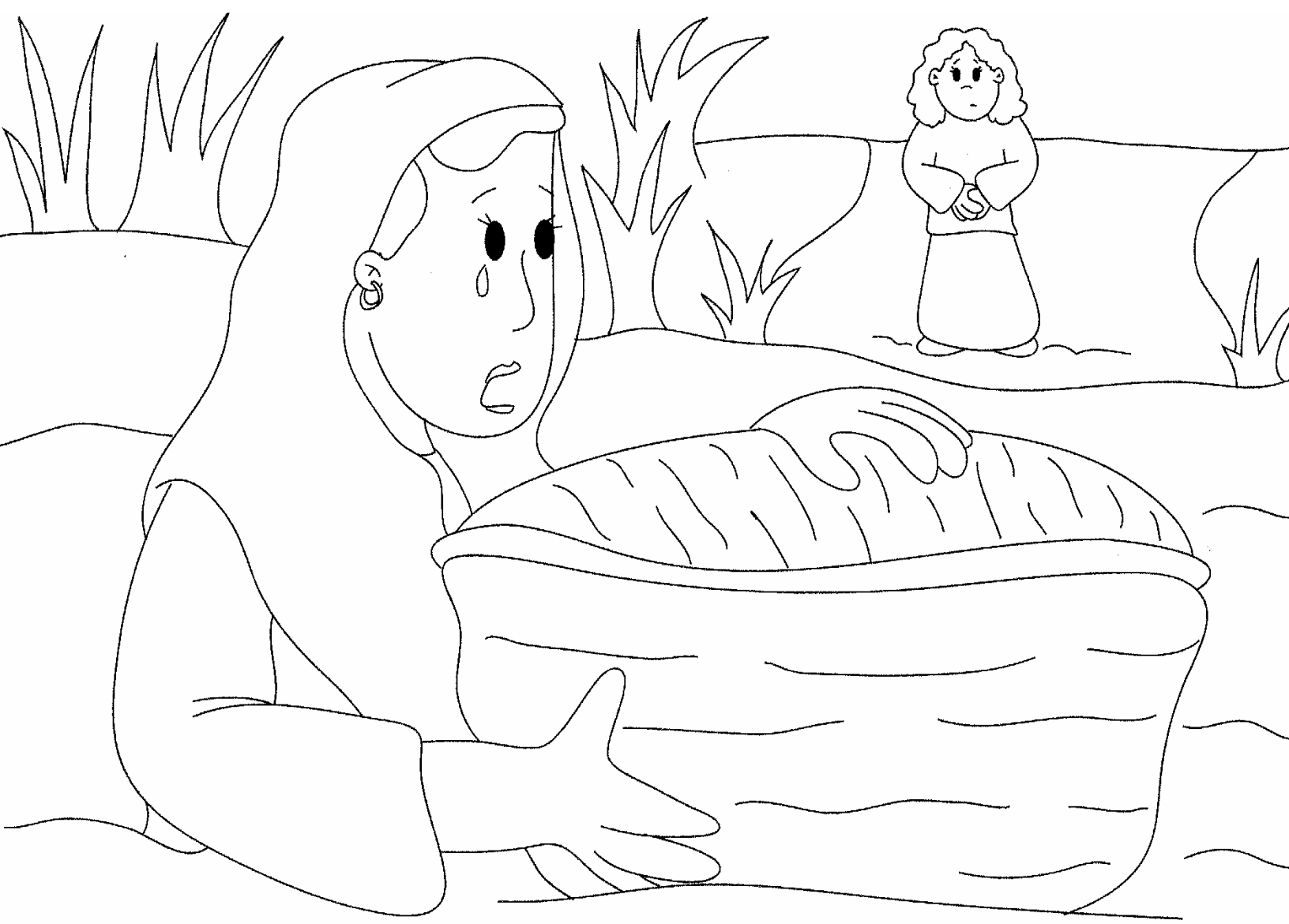
Miriam



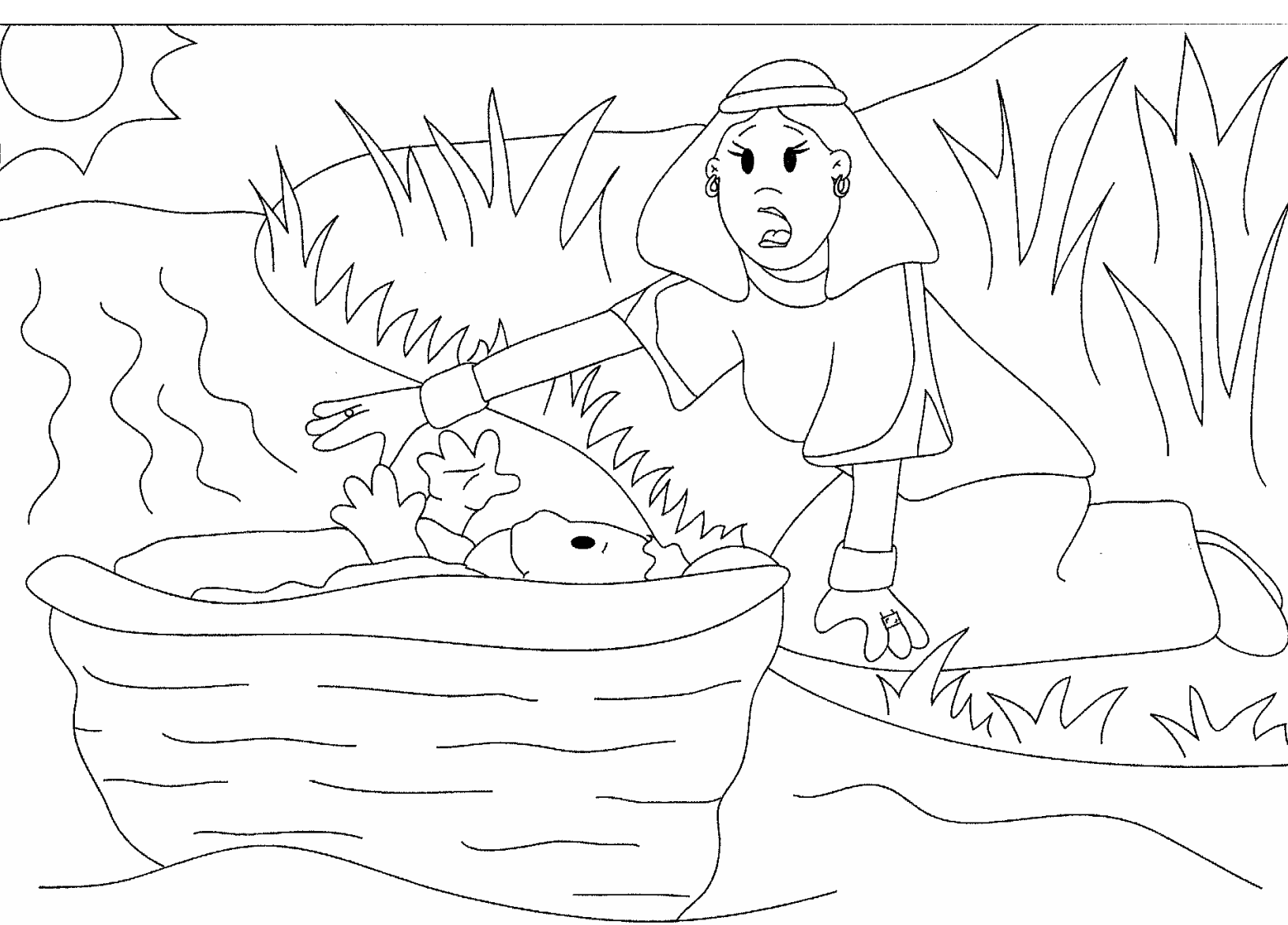

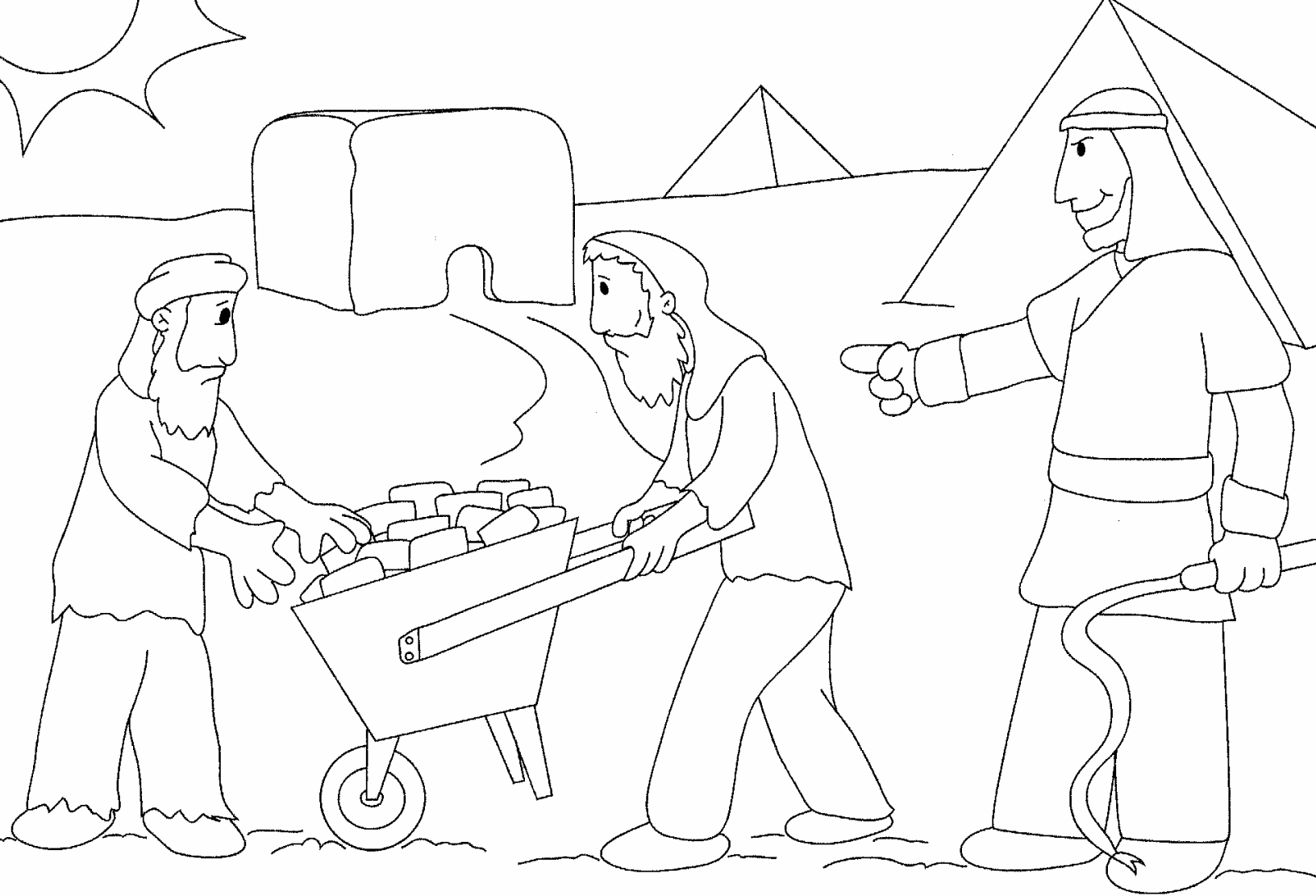
Pharaoh tried to stop the Israelite group from getting bigger by killing all of the baby boys by throwing them in the river.



Moses' mother tried to save her new born son by putting him in a basket and floating him on the river. Moses' sister, Miriam followed him as he floated.



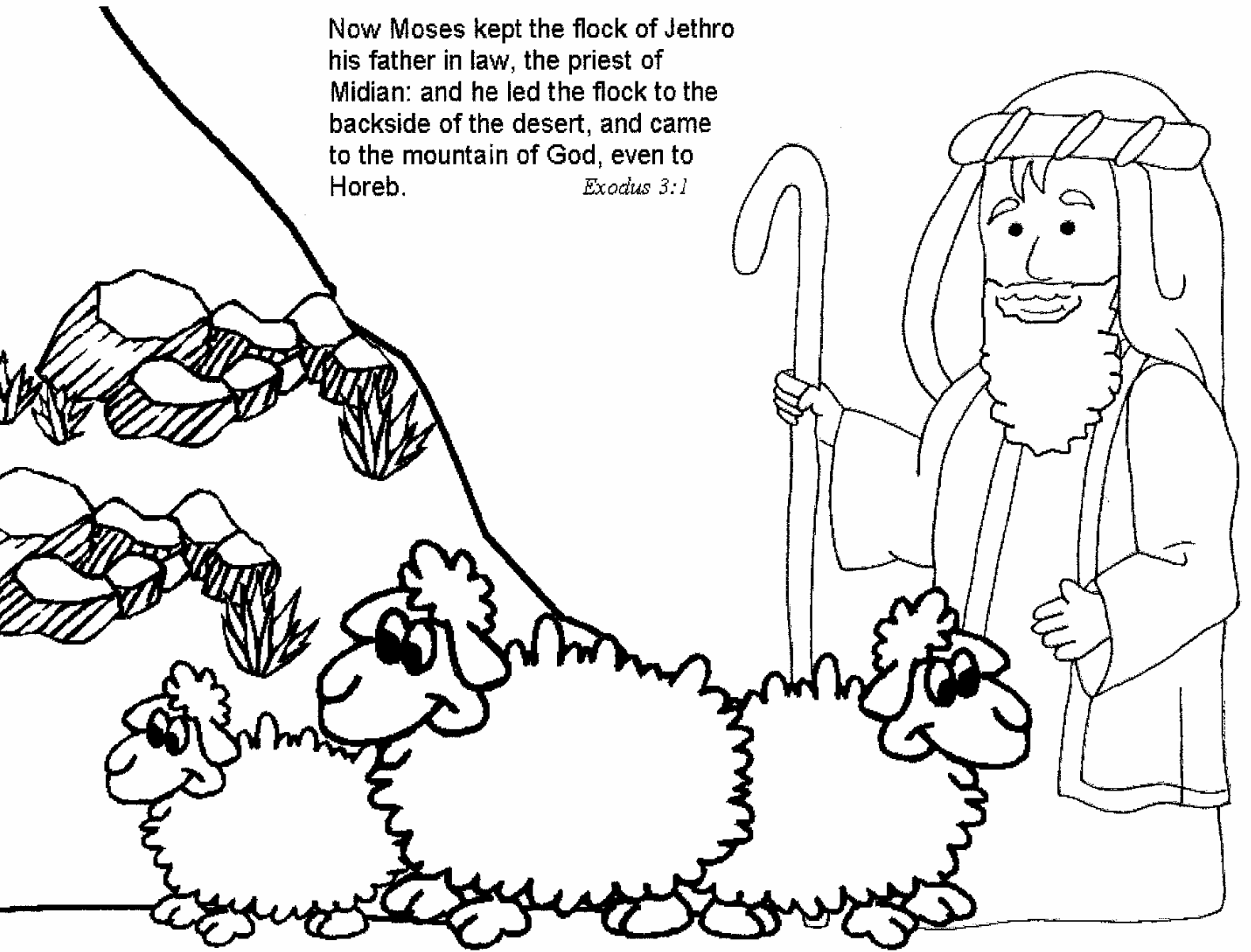
Pharaoh's daughter was bathing in the river when she ***found baby Moses floating in the river.***

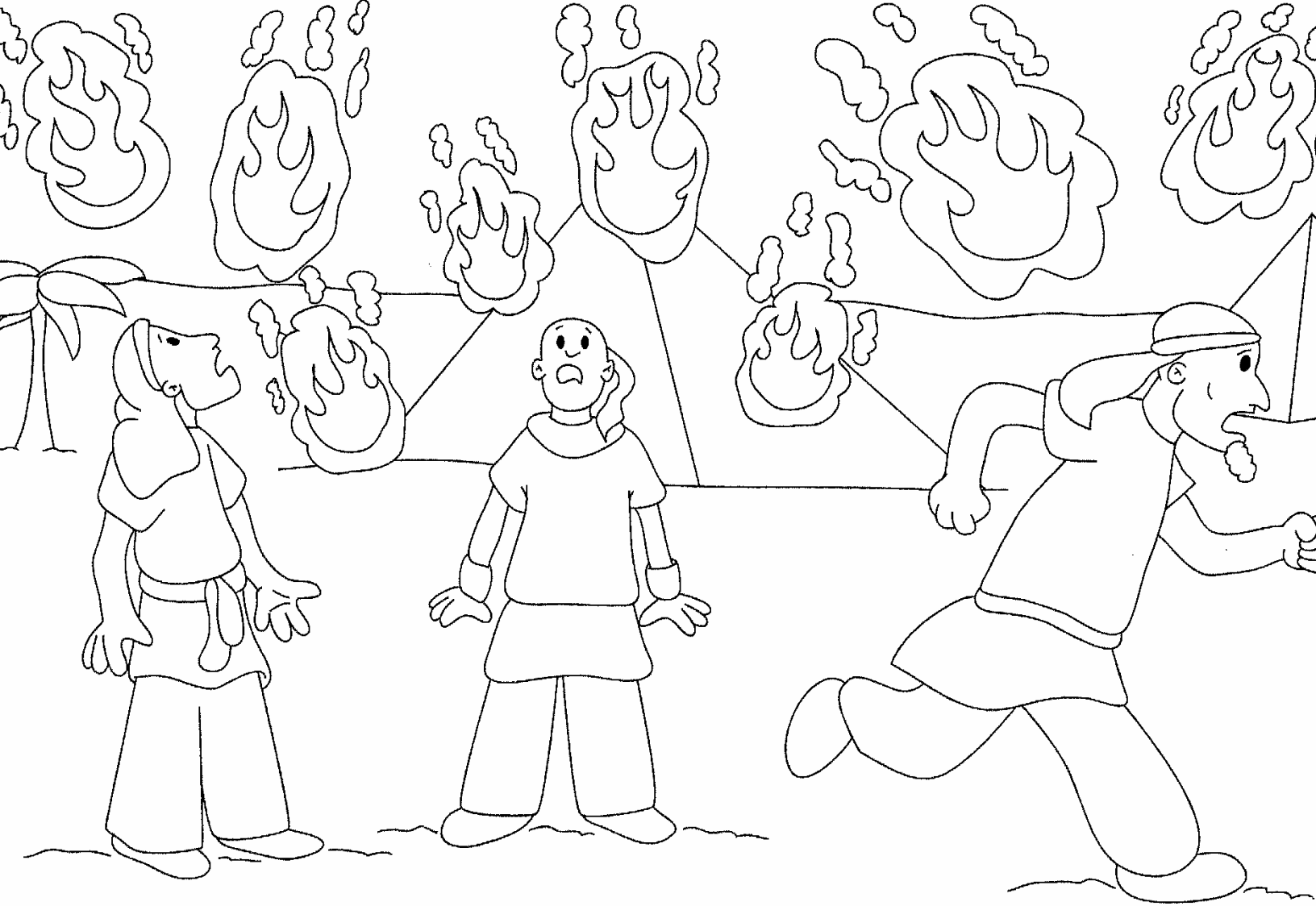
Pharaoh refused to let the Israelites go so God persuaded Pharaoh by sending 10 plagues upon the land of Egypt.

First the Nile River turned to blood. Second, Egypt was covered with frogs.

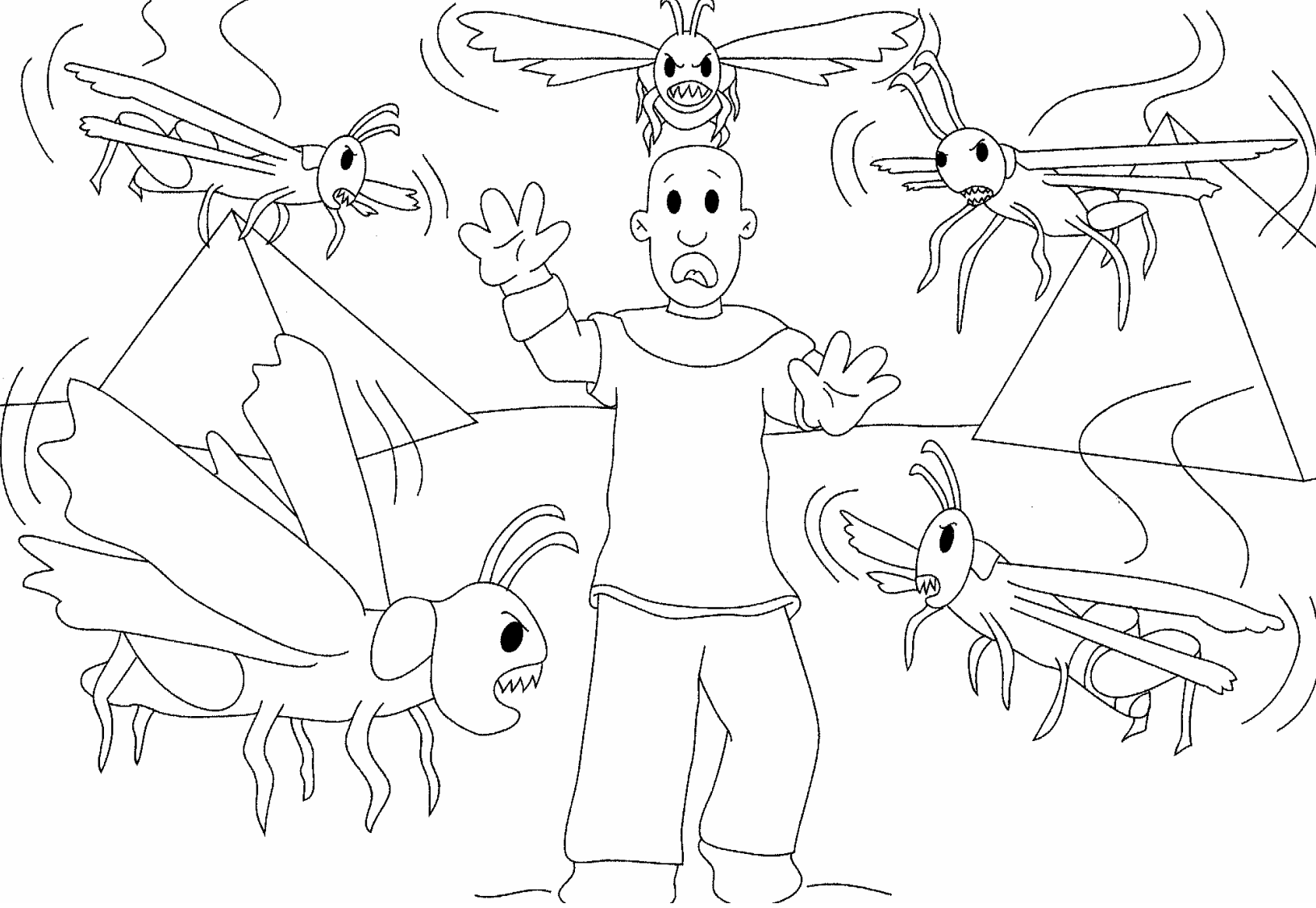


Pharaoh still refused to let the Israelites go so God turned the dust into gnats and flies that covered the Egyptians and their animals.

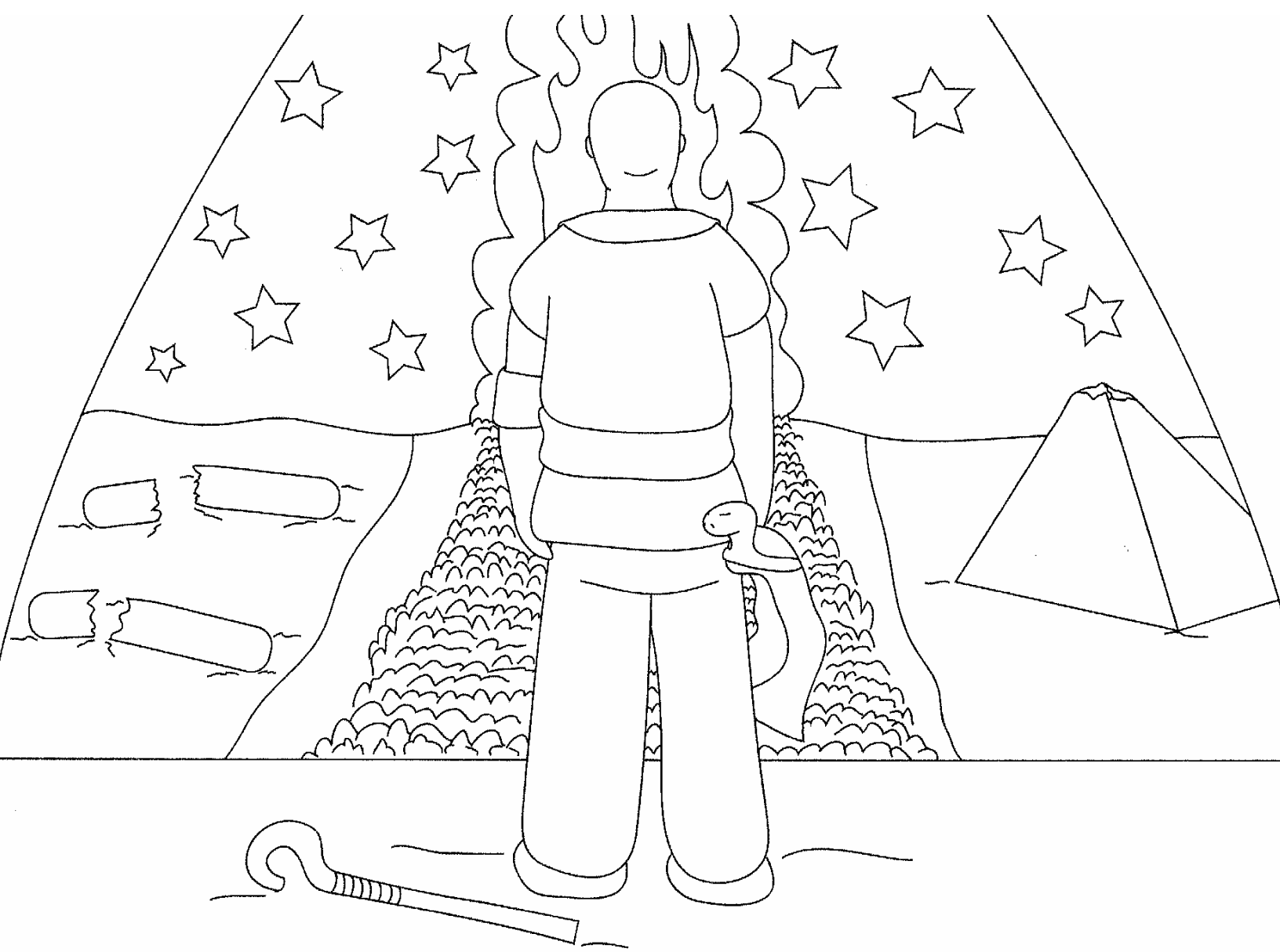
Pharaoh was still being stubborn so God sent a plague of locusts that ate all the plants and leaves off the trees so the Egyptians wouldn't have any food.
